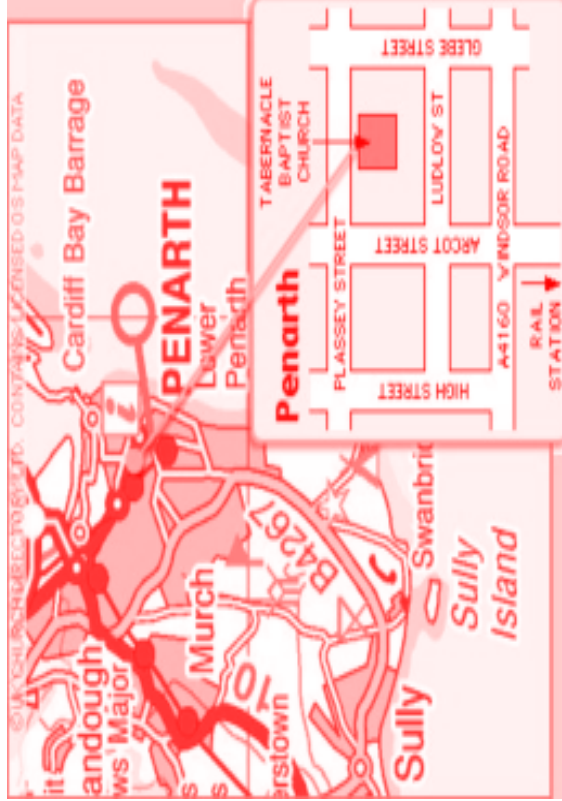

Healing Prayer Ministry

Designed to give an introduction to the theology and practice of praying for the sick, this Tabernacle Course will run on **Friday 17th and Saturday 18th March 2006**

The course will explore a theological and Biblical basis for the practice of praying for the sick, look at the healing ministry of Jesus, the Apostles and the Church in history, and provide a practical model of how to pray for healing.

The course fee is £10.00 payable at registration on the first session attended. However, sponsorships are available for the unwaged or those on low incomes.

No previous experience or knowledge is required for this course.

The Friday session begins at **7.30pm** and will conclude by **9.30pm** with a short refreshment break part way through the evening. The Saturday will commence at 9.30am and finish by 4.00pm

Course Outline & description

Introduction & assumptions

An introduction to the course, including an overview of the practice of praying for the sick and the healing ministry in Church history and a summary of the assumptions that will be made during the course.

Kingdom paradigms

Jesus came "teaching... preaching the good news of the kingdom, and healing every disease and sickness among the people." What was the understanding of the "Kingdom of God" in Biblical times, How did Jesus re-define it with his teaching, and why did it play such a central part in Jesus' ministry?

Categories of healing

Jesus used many different modes of ministry when ministering to the sick, and seemed to indicate that there may be different types of sickness and approaches to healing them. How does understanding this help us to minister effectively?

Integrated prayer model

How do we go about praying for the sick? This session provides a practical model for ministering effectively and appropriately.

4 Putting prayer into practice

A guide to good practice in ministry, an understanding of the appropriate use of 'power' and 'authority', and an introduction to team ministry in a Church setting.
